Trained nurses (including school nurses) and other professionals involved in the management of the child or young person with diabetes.

Objectives

This study day will explore a range of clinical and psychological issues relevant to those supporting the child or young person with diabetes and their family.

Learning outcomes

By the end of the day, students will be better equipped to support the child or young person with diabetes and their family. Students will have gained up-to-date, relevant clinical information and awareness of new technologies, facilitating optimised intensive diabetes management.

Content

- Communication of the diagnosis of diabetes and its impact on children, young people and their families.
- Developing comprehensive diabetes services for children and young people.
- Strategies for coping with diabetes management at school.
- Raising awareness of the challenges faced by children and young people related to food and physical activity.
- Demonstration of the latest technologies eg insulin pump therapy, continuous blood glucose monitoring, pen devices and blood glucose and ketone meters.
- Personal stories: how services help (or hinder) support.
